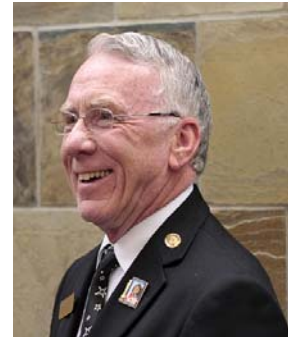
person. District Governor Virginia Edgelow and I have Zone and District goals we will be sharing at our visitations to your clubs.
